

Delayed Payment Monitoring System



The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Development (MSMED) Act, 2006 contains provisions of Delayed Payment to Micro and Small Enterprise (MSEs). (Section 15- 24).

Provision

State Governments to establish Micro and Small Enterprise Facilitation Council (MSEFC) for settlement of disputes on getting references/filing on Delayed payments. (Section 20 and 21)

Nature of assistance

MSEFC of the State after examining the case filed by MSE unit will issue directions to the buyer unit for payment of due amount along with interest as per the provisions under the MSMED Act 2006.



"Any Micro or small enterprise having valid Udyog Aadhar(UAM) can apply.

SALIENT FEATURES

The buyer is liable to pay compound interest with the monthly rests to the supplier on the amount at the three times of the bank rate notified by RBI in case he does not make payment to the supplier for his supplies of goods or services within 45 days of the acceptance of the goods/service rendered. (Section 16)

State Governments to notify (i) Authority for filing Entrepreneur Memorandum (ii) Rules of MSEFC and (iii) Constitution of MSEFC. All States/UTs have notified Authority for Filing Entrepreneur's Memorandum, 33 States/UTs (i.e. except Arunachal Pradesh, Assam and Manipur) have Notified rules of MSEFC and all the 36 States/UTs have constituted MSEFCs, as per provisions laid down under MSMED Act 2006.

Every reference made to MSEFC shall be decided within a period of ninety days from the date of making such a reference as per provisions laid in the Act. If the Appellant (not being the supplier) wants to file an appeal, no application for setting aside any decree or award by the MSEFC shall be entertained by any court unless the appellant (not being supplier) has deposited with it, the 75% of the award amount. (Section 19)

IMPLEMENTATION

The provisions under the Act are implemented by MSEFC chaired by Director of Industries of the State /UT having administrative control of the MSE units. State Government/UTs are requested to ensure that the MSE Facilitation Council hold meetings regularly and delayed payment cases are decided by the Councils within a period of 90 days as stipulated in the MSMED Act, 2006.

STEPS OF FILLING

Entrepreneur filed the application online to respective council after 15 days Council will take action on application.

Online Intimation will be Send to both Entrepreneur and Respondent by Email.

Mutual Settlement Option for Entrepreneur (MSEs can Mutual Settled the application before convert in to cases. SMS and Email send to Entrepreneur & respondent if application is converted into cases.

Council can reject the Entrepreneur Application.

Council can approve the Entrepreneur application and convert in to case. Council can enter the case detail in online portal if received online application.

Council will update case hearing status or hearing date.

Entrepreneur can view the application / case status by Udyog Aadhaar Number or Application No. / Case No.

➢ Process of Case Filing

A. Enter your Udyog Aadhaar Number and Mobile Number as in Udyog Aadhaar , and fill verification code as displayed and then click on validate Udyog Aadhaar button to receive your OTP on Email and then start filling for case.

Validate & Generate OTP

Option for Registration Without Aadhaar.

An applicant or the authorised signatory who is not yet enrolled for Aadhaar shall have to apply for Aadhaar enrolment and in case he or she is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per section 3 of the Aadhaar Act such individual may visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre to get enrolled for Aadhaar.

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, UAM registration shall be filed by the concerned DIC or MSME-DI on behalf of such enterprise, subject to the production of the following documents as alternative and viable means of identification.

- (a) (i) If he has enrolled, his Aadhaar Enrolment ID slip; or
 - (ii) A copy of his request made for Aadhaar enrolment,

(b) Any of the following documents, namely:-

Bank photo passbook; or voter ID Card; or passport; or driving license; or PAN card; or employee photo identity card issued by the Government.

Important Note : Before you proceed to file application of delayed payment, please see following.

1. You should be ready with the scanned PDF documents of work orders of Respondent and invoices generated by you against those work orders.

2. Each file size should not be more than 1MB.

3. Maximum three work orders and three invoices can be uploaded.
